1	<b>Coconut</b> <i>(May be small, large, brown or green. If you shake it and hear liquid inside, it's coconut milk!)</i>			11	<b>Seaweed</b> <i>(May be red and white, green or brown)</i>		
2	<b>Shark Eye Shell</b> <i>(May be white or cream colored. If it has an animal inside, throw it back!)</i>			12	<b>Pen shell</b> <i>(May also be dark brown. If you open it up you can often see reflective rainbow colors on the inside of the shell)</i>		
3	<b>Mangrove seed</b> <i>(Brown or green and floats in water. They are usually about 4 to 8 inches long)</i>			13	<b>Shark's tooth</b> <i>(Hard find. May be gray or black and are often very small)</i>		
4	<b>Starfish</b> <i>(If it's still alive, ask your parent to throw it back in the Gulf!)</i>			14	<b>Coral</b> <i>(May be purple, black or white and may look like a tiny round rock with little gray holes in it)</i>		
5	<b>Sand dollar</b> <i>(Dead sand dollars are white and wash ashore. Live ones are gray and live under the sand in the Gulf.)</i>			15	<b>Driftwood</b> <i>(Gray or white wood that floats in the water)</i>		
6	<b>Horseshoe crab</b> <i>(Be careful of that sharp tail! Baby horse-shoe crabs are sand-colored and often wash ashore)</i>			16	<b>Lightning welk</b> <i>(Great for souvenirs. Make sure there's not a live animal inside. If there is, throw it back!)</i>		
7	<b>Crown conch shell</b> <i>(Lucky find! If there's a live animal inside, throw it back.)</i>			17	<b>Florida fighting conch shell</b> <i>(Also make sure there's not a live animal inside)</i>		
8	<b>Fiddler crab</b> <i>(Male crabs have one very big sharp claw! Female crabs don't)</i>			18	<b>Oyster shells</b> <i>(Purple and white and often clumped together)</i>		
9	<b>Coquina Shell</b> <i>(Tiny shells that come in many colors and are often connected in the middle like a clam)</i>			19	<b>Sea urchin</b> <i>(Usually purple and very fragile)</i>		
10	<b>Seagull feather</b> <i>(May also be gray and white)</i>			20	<b>Brown algae</b> <i>(Looks like seaweed, but is much finer and delicate)</i>
